


















The KT Wong Foundation, an independent charity established in 2007 by Lady Linda Wong Davies, is dedicated to developing cultural exchange between the East and West through collaborative projects. The Foundation acts as a catalyst and producer for innovative creative ventures that seeks to bring together artists across a wide number of disciplines.

Projects have included a ground breaking production of Handel's opera Semele, directed by the highly respected Chinese artist Zhang Huan which premiered at La Theatre Royal de la Monnaie, Brussels, and then toured to the Beijing Music Festival, and BAM in New York; screenings in China of the National Theatre's Frankenstein starring Benedict Cumberbatch; the first Chinese production of Shakespeare's Coriolanus at the Edinburgh International Festival in 2013, and a collaboration with the innovative Floating Cinema by Ole Scheeren at the 2012 Venice Architectural Biennale. In 2016. the Foundation were exclusive partners in William Kentridge 's critically acclaimed opera production of Berg's *Lulu*, a co-production between the Metropolitan Opera of New York and the English National Opera.

TV projects have included documentaries coproduced with the BBC featuring musicians such as Lang Lang and Daniel Barenboim. In 2015, in partnership with Sony, the Foundation coproduced *Lang Lang in concert from Versailles* for film and TV.

Projects in 2017 include creating and promoting a major festival at the South Bank in London with the Philharmonia Orchestra to celebrate the Chinese New Year; a commission by South African composer Neo Muyanga to accompany *Passage* by Mohau Modisakeng at the 57th Venice Biennale, and a new production of the opera *Greek* by Mark Anthony Turnage at the Edinburgh International Festival.
